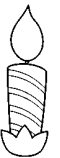


Please join us for this

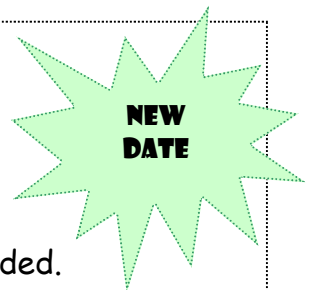
